

Europe's first community energy accreditation scheme for municipalities



The accreditation scheme

The LIFE LOOP community energy accreditation is the first ever scheme that acknowledges municipalities demonstrating foresightedness in energy community matters. It is free of charge for local authorities and has been designed to require as little time as possible for participating local authority representatives participating in it.

This scheme is open for all municipalities, their local leaders and civil servants, no matter whether they are at the beginning, or later stage in their community energy journey.

Three good reasons to sign up



Assess your current status with the self-assessment tracker: How much of a community energy supporter is your municipality and what is missing?



Encourage in-house capacity-building, i.e. providing staff time to develop new skills and knowledge through the tailored on-line Community Energy Espresso course
